## Article II, Section 2 – Admission to Membership

- a. Club Member
- b. Each new Club Member shall be a soccer club **registering a minimum of twenty-five (25) players in year one, thirty-five (35) in year two, and fifty (50) in year three** and registered as such on the membership registration system maintained at the State Office. An officer from a new club will be interviewed by the District Commissioner for the district in which the proposed member has been organized, to understand the short (1 year) and medium term (3 year) plans for the new club. The District Commissioner shall propose each new club membership to the BOD. Club membership registration shall be made in writing upon a form specified by the State Office, and election to membership shall be made by resolution adopted by the BOD. **Prior to being accepted into membership each new club must have its bylaws approved by NYSW and a copy of these approved bylaws placed on file in the NYSW State Office.**
