## NYSW Policy on Indoor Soccer

To be covered by NYSW insurance while playing indoor soccer, all players and coaches must be registered with their club using GotSport.

To avoid issues with National Championship Series and travel soccer rules, all indoor play in NYSW is considered recreational soccer. For indoor teams, please be sure to set up your teams correctly using the team type 'recreational'. If you set them up as travel, the GotSport program will invoke the two-roster limit for your players. In the past this has caused a problem once spring rolls around and teams head outside as true classic travel programs. If you set the indoor team as travel, you will also incur player pass fees to your invoice.

NYSW does not sanction indoor soccer leagues or tournaments. This means that COI's obtained by clubs for facilities to be used during indoor training <u>are not valid for Indoor Tournaments</u> and the facilities <u>do not have liability protection</u> through our insurance for these events.

If you are properly registered in GotSport, you will be covered while participating in these events. NYSW insurance is also in effect while training at an indoor facility.
